Hearing Test

To determine if there has been a significant change in your hearing, once a year we will screen your hearing in our sound booth. Using a clinical audiometer, we can evaluate how well you are hearing, and, if the results warrant it, show you how you can hear better.

Ostoscopic Inspection

A thorough inspection with a otoscope can detect the presence of a common hindrance to better hearing - wax buildup. This check-up ensures that no obstacles impede the effectiveness of your aid.

Cleaning The Ear Mold

Using our ultrasonic cleaning system, we will wash your ear mold and, if necessary, replace the tubing.

Servicing The Aid

Simple preventative maintenance can help you avoid the most frequent cause of hearing malfunction - corrosion. To keep your aid working at its best, we will clean the contacts, volume control, and battery compartment.

Analyzing The Aid

Because minute changes in amplification can diminish the performance of your aid, we will test it in our Fonix Sound Chamber. This computer controlled unit assesses your aid's amplifying characteristics and produces a printout showing how well your aid adheres to the manufacturer's original specifications

Loaner Aid

If your aid requires repair, we will loan you an aid from our stock of hearing aids. Available as part of our Hearing Service Plan, a loaner aid provides a dependable alternative while your aid is being repaired.
